LAUDATO SI' - OUR COMMON HOME

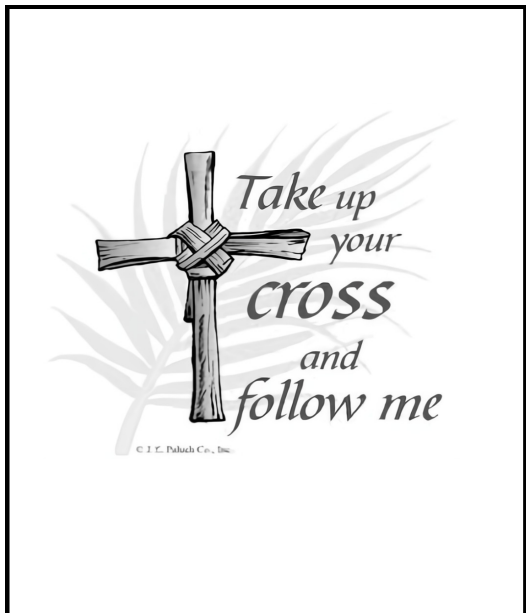
Job 9.9: "He is the Maker of the Bear and Orion, of Pleiades, and the constellations of the south"
