This Foundation was established in 2013 by Bishop Colin and has now grown to a total of \$1,295,354.63 largely due to a number of bequests being directed into the Foundation over the years. We also have a Catholic Caring Fund of \$37,352.00 that can be drawn on throughout the year. This is made up of money gifted throughout the year, with a number of parishioners generously contributing regularly. The income from the appeal goes into the Foundation Account. This money is invested so as to provide a regular return to the diocese to help fund our social and pastoral outreach.
