Message to the Dunedin Diocese from Bishop Michael Dooley

The Prime Minister announced Friday (14 August) at 5:30pm, that we will continue at Level 2 for another 12 days. For many, the restrictions will be disappointing but we pray for a swift return to our normal Masses and worship.

Staying at level 2 means that Masses will continue in the Diocese with a maximum of 100 people. Social distancing, contact tracing and sanitising of hands needs to be practiced. Some parishes may cancel Sunday Masses due to issues with management of numbers of people. The dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation is in place for Level 2. There is an online Mass available from Mercy Parish, South Dunedin, at 9:30am on Sunday morning. There is a link to this Mass on the parish webpage: www.mercyparish.nz. There is also Mass screened on Shine TV on Sunday afternoon.

Thank you all for your cooperation and support in these challenging days. We pray at this time for God to bless each one of us and our country with protection and guidance.
