Following the Parish Council Meeting, the following protocols must be adhered to for Sunday Mass:

- As numbers are limited to a hundred (COVID-19 Alert Level 2 rules), we encourage you to consider the other alternatives; Vigil Mass at Omakau and Sunday Mass at Roxburgh (please note Mass times on the side of this newsletter).
- 2) For contact tracing purposes, you will be required to sign in before entering the Church. Please ensure you use the sanitiser provided.
- 3) For seating, rows will be marked with white tape to ensure that the 1-metre social distancing is followed.
- 4) Collection baskets will be placed on the Offertory table.
- 5) Holy Communion will be under one kind (to be received on hand only) and distributed by Fr Sani.
- 6) When leaving the Church, please remember to maintain your distance.
- Please note that there is dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass should you feel you have any health related concerns.
