The symbolism of Advent Wreath Candles

Set on the branches of the Advent wreath are four candles; three purple candles and one pink candle. A more modern tradition is to place a white candle in the center of the wreath. As a whole, these colored advent candles represent the coming of the light of Christ into the world. Each week of Advent Sunday, a particular Advent candle is lit. Catholic tradition states that the four candles representing the four weeks of Advent, each stand for one thousand years, to total the 4000 years from the time of Adam and Eve until the birth of the Savior.

Prophecy Candle

On the first Sunday of Advent, the first purple candle is lit. This candle is called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets who foretold the birth of Christ. This first candle represents hope or expectation in anticipation of the coming Messiah.


