#### Based on John 1:29, 32-34

In the gospel of John, another John, the Baptist, had a problem. He did not know who God had sent to save his people. Then, he saw Jesus and announced to the crowd, "Look! The Lamb of God!"

Now John knew. This man named Jesus would die for the sins of everyone, just like the animal that the priests in the Temple sacrifice for the sins of the people. The animal took the place of the worshipers at the Temple. Jesus would take our place.

But, why Jesus? John saw the answer. God had poured his Spirit into this man. The power of God was in Jesus. And he would share that power with his disciples.

John saw the Spirit in Jesus. But who invited John to recognize Jesus in the first place? God's Spirit. The third person of the Holy Trinity, invites us, like John, to recognize Jesus as our Savior. Once we accept his invitation, the Spirit brings all of God, Father, Son, and Spirit, to live in us. As God's power, the Spirit introduces us to Jesus, invites us to believe, and bring the Trinity to live within us. word-sunday.com
