Here is a message from Fr Mark Chamberlain



In Sunday's section of the Gospel of John, the phrase " **they know his voice**" has been with me as I have been reflecting and preparing towards Sunday. The hearing of or a sensing of a "voice" within is probably the most common characteristic of those wondering about priesthood or religious life. Those discerning a vocation frequently describe a quiet voice inspiring their search. In difficult seasons or in times of new energy for mission, this voice of the Good Shepherd is quietly heard, while it sustains and then eventually propels us into a new ministry future.

We are all grateful for the prayers for vocations to priesthood and religious life, we can all recall parishioners who do just that. At Waikouaiti , Sunday after Sunday, the congregation prays for vocations. God continues to answer our prayers but often in an unexpected or unplanned manner. On Friday the 14th we celebrated Peter's priestly ordination with such prayerful joy and such a tangible sense of the rightness of this moment, on Saturday 20th of May we will gather for the ordination to the permanent Diaconate for losefa in Balclutha and then on Saturday 24th June, we will celebrate the priestly ordination for Suu and Jospeh. In reflecting with gratitude for each one we can recognise God's response to our prayers.

I invite us to continue to pray for Peter, losefa and Fania, Suu, Joseph, Tang and Shane.

May they always be encouraged in hearing his voice. Currently, I have two others who are prayerfully discerning, so prayers for John and Sam would be appreciated. May we have the be grace to be open to his voice.

Thank you for drawing attention to the need for prayer for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.
