

February 8 is the Feast of St Bless us God with hearts that grieve injustice.

St Bakhita is the patron of all those who are enslaved or trafficked. Bakhita was a Sudanese child who was kidnapped, sold several times, tortured and ill-treated and finally protected by the Canossian Sisters in Italy and freed. She became a sister herself and lived in Italy, dying in 1947. She was canonised in 2000 by Pope John Paul II and Pope Francis has made her the patron of the anti-slavery movement.

Pope Francis' essential message on this subject is that "human trafficking is an "open wound on the body of contemporary society, a crime against humanity and an atrocious scourge that is occurring in many of our own neighbourhoods."

Let us join Pope Francis in praying for all who are trafficked and their perpetrators.
