The occasion was a very happy one as there was lots of chatter and sharing of stories about the second hand items that had passed through the doors of the local shop and many of the group wore items of clothing and jewelry and accessories purchased from the store. Over the last few years Oasis has gifted over \$80,000 to CSS from their successful venture, which has been very gratefully received to help them continue the work of Catholic Social Services locally.
